Per *Official Gazette* post, President Benigno S. Aquino III signed Proclamation No. 4¹ entitled DECLARING THE REGULAR HOLIDAYS, SPECIAL (NON-WORKING) DAYS, AND SPECIAL HOLIDAY (FOR ALL SCHOOLS) FOR THE YEAR 2013.

According to Proclamation No. 459, the Philippines' 2013 holidays are categorized in three: Regular Holidays, Special Non-Working Days, and Special Holiday (for all schools).

The proclamation also has provisions for the national holidays in observance of Eid' Fitir and Eid ul Adha, but the exact dates are still to be determined in accordance with the Islamic calendar.

Holidays in 2014 are listed according to their original dates pending the issuance of Presidential proclamation.
