

100 CPAs from 100 Graduates in 2012: CBA Scores 100% Passing in 2012 CPA Exams

UPCBA obtained 100% passing percentage in the two board examinations for Certified Public Accountants (CPA) given last May and October 2012. All the 94 graduates passed the CPA examination in October and another six graduates passed the May CPA examination. This is the first time since 2000 that the College produced 100 CPAs. The College admits only 100 accounting majors every year in the UP College Admission Test (UPCAT).

A total of 4,772 of 9,987 accountancy graduates passed the October licensure exam, for a national passing rate of 47.78%. UPCBA, is the only accounting school with 100% passing percentage.

Four UPCBA graduates made it to top 10 in October 2012: Trishia Julienne C. Simeon, 2nd, Mary Anne Jelli E. Gaza, 5th, Brad Neiel T. Dela Cruz, 7th and Charlton Sean D. Gaerlan II, 9th. During the May 2012 CPA examination, Jessica Jean G. Gandeza placed 8th.
