The UNSW PhD Scholarship program for KoSASA (Korean Studies Association of South East Asia) member universities was established to support cooperation in research and education between UNSW and KoSASA member universities. With this scholarship, UNSW offers outstanding young scholars from KoSASA member universities opportunity to study at UNSW towards a PhD degree.

Interested applicants must satisfy the following conditions:

1. Candidates must be a Masters graduate of a KoSaSa-member University (e.g. UP), or faculty and staff with an appropriate Master's degree; and
2. Must meet the normal selection criteria for entry in UNSW Phd program, including academic performance and language requirements

Requirements:

1. Expression of Intent
2. 1-page Curriculum Vitae (educational qualification with GPA, TOEFL/IELTS results, job experience, research output)
3. Academic Transcripts
4. Research Proposal
5. Graduation certificate from UPD
6. Certificate of employment from UPD (if applicable)

The deadline for submission of the requirements is on **10 October 2017**. The Office of International Linkages, UP System is located in the 3rd Floor of the South Wing of the Quezon Hall, UP Diliman.
