## WHO ARE NOT QUALIFIED TO JOIN

- Teachers who have previous or pending administrative, civil or criminal cases
- Teachers who were prosecuted in any civil or criminal cases
- Teachers who were suspended, reprimanded, or sanctioned for violation of any administrative policies

<b>Validation and Interview / Establishment of Profile / Background Check</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Short-listed nominees are contacted and an interview is scheduled.</li><li>2. The interview validates the qualification of the nominee and establishes his/her profile.</li><li>3. Based on the results of the interview and background check, the Screening Committee selects the finalists.</li></ol>
<b>Selection of Honorees</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. From the finalists, the Board of Judges selects the honorees to represent this year's The Many Faces of the Teacher.</li></ol>
<b>Media Plan</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. A media plan is developed to highlight the personalities of the honorees.</li><li>2. A photo shoot is scheduled.</li><li>3. A series of ads, press releases, and collaterals are produced to promote the exemplary traits of the honorees.</li></ol>
