#### 1. Grant for Japan-Related Research Projects<sup>1</sup>

Research projects carried out by East and Southeast Asian researchers (individuals or groups) in Social Sciences or the Humanities, which are related to Japan

Deadline of application: 01 September – 31 October 2019

Grant Period: One year (April 2020 through March 2021), but can be extended by another year

maximum upon request

Grant amount for each project: Maximum of ¥2 million

Grant Budget: ¥50 million in total, with approximately 80 projects to be selected

## 2. Grant for Projects for the Protection, Preservation & Restoration of Cultural Properties outside Japan<sup>1</sup>

- (a) Projects for the protection, preservation & restoration of cultural properties (fine arts & historical monuments) outside Japan which are tangible, old and artistically or academically valuable and ought to be handed down to future generations
- (b) Preliminary surveys immediately linked up with the projects in (a) above

#### Qualifications:

- 1. Applicant shall be the owner(s) or administrator(s) of the cultural properties or researcher(s), who will actually conduct preliminary surveys.
- 2. The following are not eligible:
  - a. Profit making organizations:
  - Individuals who own cultural properties for profit or whose cultural properties are for private use only

Grant Period: One year (April 2020 through March 2021), but can be extended by another year

Grant Budget: ¥70 million in total, with approximately 40 projects to be selected
